

ORDINANCE 2024-59

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TITLE V, LEGISLATIVE, CHAPTER 55, POLICE AND FIREFIGHTERS RETIREMENT PENSION PLAN, BY MODIFYING PROVISIONS RELATED TO RETIREMENT DATES AND BENEFITS FOR FIREFIGHTER MEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN THE CITY OF PALM BAY CODE OF ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Palm Bay Police Officers' and Firefighters' Retirement System ("Pension Plan") is governed by Chapters 175 and 185, Florida Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the City of Palm Bay has a Police Officers' and Firefighters' Retirement System for the benefit of City police officers and firefighters, and

WHEREAS, the City of Palm Bay and the IAFF Local 2446 entered into a new Agreement executed on August 16, 2024, after ratification by the City Council on May 16, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the new Agreement is effective October 1, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the Parties agreed to an increase in the Supplemental Benefit for Firefighter Members meeting certain qualifications effective October 1, 2024, and

WHEREAS, the Palm Bay City Council has determined that the passage of this ordinance is in accord with the Agreement reached by the City of Palm Bay and the IAFF Local 2446, and

WHEREAS, the Palm Bay City Council has determined that the passage of this ordinance is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Palm Bay.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM BAY, BREVARD COUNTY, FLORIDA, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City of Palm Bay Code of Ordinances, Title V, Legislative, Chapter 55, Police and Firefighters Retirement Pension Plan, Section 55.07, Retirement Dates and Benefits, is hereby amended and shall henceforth read as follows:

"Section 55.07 RETIREMENT DATES AND BENEFITS.

* * *

(D) Supplemental Benefit for Firefighter Members. Effective October 1, 2007, firefighter members who either terminate while vested or reach normal retirement or early retirement shall receive a supplemental benefit of twenty- five dollars (\$25.00) per month for each year of credited service earned prior to March 15, 2012. Effective March 15, 2012, members who have not attained age 55 with 10 or more years of credited service or 25 years of credited service regardless of age on that date, who either terminate while vested or terminate upon reaching normal or early retirement shall receive a supplemental benefit of \$12.00 per month for each year of credited service earned on or after March 15, 2012. This benefit shall only be paid for the life of the member and will not be paid to disabled members who are being retained on the City's insurance at the expense of the City. >>Effective October 1, 2024, firefighter members who thereafter either terminate while vested or reach normal retirement or early retirement shall receive a supplemental benefit of thirty dollars (\$30.00) per month for each year of credited service. This benefit shall only be paid for the life of the member and will not be paid to disabled members who are being retained on the City's insurance at the expense of the City.<< The benefit shall commence upon entry into the DROP or upon receipt of a retirement benefit and separation from the City. This benefit shall cease when the member attains the age of Medicare eligibility."


SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances not in conflict herewith are hereby continued in full force and effect.


SECTION 3. It is the intention of the City Council of the City of Palm Bay that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be made a part of the City of Palm Bay Code of Ordinances and the sections may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.


SECTION 4. If any portion, clause, phrase, sentence, or classification of this ordinance is held or declared to be either unconstitutional, invalid, inapplicable, inoperative, or void, then such declaration shall not be construed to affect other portions of the ordinance; it is hereby declared to be the express opinion of the City Council of the City of Palm Bay that any such unconstitutional, invalid, inapplicable, inoperative, or void portion or portions of this ordinance did not induce its passage, and that without the inclusion of any such portion or portions of this ordinance, the City Council would have enacted the valid constitutional portions thereof.

SECTION 5. The provisions within this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon the enactment date.
